

K-2 Reopening Plan Daily Operations “Quick Notes”

Main Information:

- ❖ Each grade will be broken up into two different cohorts of no more than 12 students. Both cohorts will attend school 5 days a week. One cohort will attend in the morning and the other in the afternoon.
- ❖ Cohort A schedule will attend school from 7:50am to 10:45am. Cohort B will attend school from 12:15pm to 3:10pm.
- ❖ An online option will be available for any student that wants to stay at home. A student choosing the online model will have the opportunity to return to campus for in-person instruction. However, a student is either full-time online or full-time in person and will need to notify administration before the approval to switch.
- ❖ All online classes will be in the morning cohort. If a student is returning to school for on campus instruction from the online class, they may be placed in either the AM or PM cohort.

Preventative Safety Measures:

- ❖ Between cohorts, each classroom and all equipment will be cleaned and sanitized before the next cohort enters. Students will have their own individualized desk and will not share any materials or workstations as a student from a different cohort.
- ❖ Students will be required to wear masks at all times except for the following while eating or during strenuous exercise.
- ❖ At St. Jude’s we believe that students need to have a great balance of academic instruction and social-emotional development. We have extended the time that students may be on campus to allow as much social-emotional development as possible in the given school day. Each class will have two 15 minute breaks in which students can safely play, socialize and eat a snack. All breaks will be staggered to eliminate cohorts crossing.

Parent Protocols and Drop-Off/Pick-Up Information:

- ❖ There will be no visitors allowed on campus during school hours unless otherwise approved by administration or in the case of an emergency.
- ❖ No person may enter a building on campus without using our new temperature stations posted in front of the school and outside of the office.
- ❖ Car Loop For Drop-Off and Pick-Up will be the same. Please see below for details about how to properly drop-off or pick-up your child: Due to the small size of our on campus students at any given time (between 23-28 students), we will be able to have one loop at this time.
