## IN PERSON AND VIRTUAL MEET & GREET

Students of all grades (K-8) need to log on no later than 1pm. Attendance will be taken. Your teacher will email you by Friday, August 21st, with your login information.

All students should practice logging into their email addresses before the first day of school.

## RULES & POLICIES

Please show up at your scheduled time. Any student arriving after their scheduled time may not have the opportunity to meet their teacher. All students 3rd grade and above must wear a mask.

All parents must wear a mask at all times. Upon arrival, every person walking on campus will have their temperature taken. Anyone with a temperature 100 degrees or higher will not be allowed in.

Parents of students in K-2 may have a parent walk on campus with them.

Parents of students in grades 3-8 are not permitted on campus. We are trying to limit the amount of people coming on campus and to follow regulations, we can only have necessary participants on campus. If your child needs help getting their supplies from the classroom to the car, we will have staff on site to support. **Please bring an empty backpack!**

Parents may park their car, wait for their child and then take a photo in our designated photo area.
