Please consider purchasing supplies for our sister school, Holy Spirit, which is located in Downtown Los Angeles. Requested supplies are listed on each page, although all classroom supplies are appreciated!



# Kindergarten

- 1 pack Elmer's glue sticks, 12 count (small, purple)
- 2 packages Crayola twistable crayons (24 count each)- not scented
- 1 Sterilite plastic pencil box (8 ⅜" by 5 ⅝")- any color
- 1 pack Pentel Hi-Polymer Erasers, 4 count
- 1 package Expo Dry Erase Marker, low odor, chisel tip, 8-count (assorted colors)
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors 5" kids, blunt/rounded- any color
- 1 Carson Dellosa Chairback Buddy Pocket Chart- blue & red (Found on Amazon)
- 1 package Ticonderoga Beginner Primary size pencils, without eraser, 12 count
- (2) two-pocket **plastic** folders- yellow & blue
- Backpack (large enough to hold a folder)
- 1 lunch box labeled with student's name
- 1 sock (used to erase our whiteboards)
- 1 change of socks/underwear/bottoms (accidents happen)- put in a ziploc labeled with student's name- these do not need to be uniform
- 1 set of headphones in a ziploc labeled with student's name (no earbuds)
- 1 Reusable Bag large enough for books- labeled with name

- 4 two-pocket plastic folders one red, one blue, one green and one yellow
- 1 small package of crayons- not scented
- 1 package of wide tip markers- not scented
- 1 package of colored pencils- not scented
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 paper towel roll
- 1 fine tip black EXPO marker for whiteboards and one gently used sock
- 2 wide tip colored EXPO markers
- 1 set of headphones in a Ziploc labeled with student's name (no earbuds)
- 2 Clorox/Lysol Wipes
- Last names A-J: 1 box sandwich size Ziploc bags
- Last names A-J: 1 pack of Astrobright paper (not cardstock)
- Last names K-Z: 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags
- Last names K-Z: 1 package of Avery 2x4 labels

# Second Grade

- Backpack (please place the items below into their backpacks)

  - 1 composition notebook

  - 1 set of headphones (**no ear buds**)
  - 1 pack of thin EXPO markers
  - 1 lunchbox
  - St. Jude Assignment Notebook (purchased in the office for \$5)
- 1 LARGE fanny pack (please place the supplies below into their fanny pack)
  - 1 package of crayons
  - 1 package of colored pencils
  - 1 personal pencil sharpener with cap for pencil shavings
  - 1 pair of small scissors
  - 4 glue sticks
  - 2 red pens
- 1 Reusable Bag large enough for books- labeled with name (please place the supplies below into their bag)

# Third Grade

- 24 sharpened no. 2 pencils (Ticonderoga only) (No mechanical pencils)
- 1 small box of crayons (24 pack)
- 1 box fine tip colored markers (no scented markers)
- 1 pair of small pointed scissors
- 3 red pens for self-correcting pens
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 small pencil sharpener with a cover for individual use
- 6 glue sticks (1 to be put in fanny pack)
- 1 fanny pack (large enough for supplies: pencils, eraser, scissor, glue, crayons). Please place the **above items** in the fanny pack to be ready on the 1st day. Not all pencils will fit, please have your child keep the extra in the backpack.
- 4 Perforated wide ruled spiral notebooks (different colors preferred)
  - Please label each **on the bottom** of the notebooks, include student's name and subject: Social Studies, Math, Language Arts, and Journal
- 1 backpack (roller backpacks OK)
- 12" ruler with inches and centimeters (not bendable, need to be sturdy plastic or wood)
- 6 dry erase markers (not thin)
- 10 two-pocket folders (different colors preferred)
  - Please label **on the bottom** of the folder with student's name and name of subject: Parent, Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, Spelling, Religion, Classwork, Book Report, Homework
- 1 set of earbuds or headphones (to be kept in the class, in a baggie or case with name on it)
- 2 white board erasers (small if you can find them)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 2 containers of hand wipes
- 1 Lysol spray
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- St. Jude School assignment notebook (purchased in school office)

- 5 blue or black ballpoint pens
- 3 red pens for correcting
- 2 highlighters
- 1 24-pack of crayons **OR** 1 set of colored pencils
- 1 set of *thin* markers
- 4 small glue sticks (clear or purple)
- 1 pair of small scissors
- 1 12" ruler with inches and centimeters
- 2 thin, black Expo markers
- 1 old, unstained sock *or* white board eraser
- 1 graph paper spiral notebook
- 6 College-ruled spiral notebooks
- 6 pocket folders (color-coding the notebooks & folders is ideal but not required)
- 1 pencil bag big enough for the following: a few pencils, erasers, all colored pens, highlighters, scissors & glue
- 1 8 ½ by 5 ½ pencil box (all remaining art supplies to fit inside)
- 1 set of headphones for computer use
- 2 containers of Clorox/Lysol Wipes **OR** 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 personal hand sanitizer
- 1 backpack- roller is fine though difficult with the stairs
- 1 reusable lunch box
- 1 St. Jude School planner (purchased in school office for \$5)
